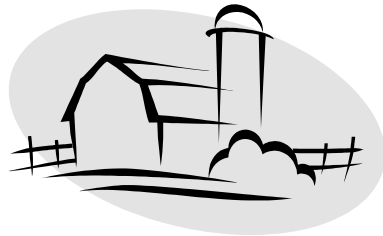


New Hampshire 2009 CSA's
