NEW HAMPSHIRE BANKING DEPARTMENT TO HOLD SEMINARS ON ALTERNATIVES TO FORECLOSURE

Concord, NH – The New Hampshire Banking Department has organized several informational seminars designed to assist residents facing foreclosure. The sessions will be held September 9th and 23rd in Concord and September 15th and 29th in Laconia. Additional seminars may be scheduled in other areas of the State.

“Our goal is to help residents understand their options and to encourage them to be proactive if they want to save their home,” stated Deputy Bank Commissioner Robert A. Fleury.

The seminars will discuss the options of the Making Home Affordable program, the NH Mediation program, short sales, and other options. Speakers will also discuss the foreclosure timeline, mortgage rescue scams, and deficiency judgments.
