ORDER

The board is in receipt of the “Town’s” February 12, 2001 response (“Response”) to the board’s January 25, 2001 order inquiring about the Town’s plans for reassessment. A greater level of detail is required before the board determines whether to proceed with an investigation of the need for a reassessment pursuant to RSA 71-B:16. The board will hold a hearing on May 24, 2001, at 9:00 a.m., in the offices of the board located at Johnson Hall, 107 Pleasant Street, Third Floor, Concord, New Hampshire. At this hearing, the Town should have its assessing personnel available to provide further information about the 1995 update and the subsequent adjustments that have occurred which were outlined in the Town’s Response. The Town should provide documentation and examples of the methodology used to perform the 1995 update and the subsequent periodic adjustments by neighborhoods or property types. The Town should also further describe its plans for funding a full reassessment.
