**ORDER**

On March 3, 2006 the New Hampshire Department of Revenue Administration (“DRA”) filed a Petition for Municipal-Wide Reassessment (“petition”) laying out the need for a reassessment to be performed in the “Town”. DRA requested the board accept the petition to establish jurisdiction over the 2006 statistical update being proposed by the Warren selectmen, but to hold the petition in abeyance subject to the Town raising and appropriating adequate funds at the 2006 annual town meeting to carry out the update.

The board grants DRA’s request. DRA shall inform the board as to the result of the town meeting vote, no later than March 31, 2006. Based on the result of the town meeting, the board will either hold a hearing or entertain motions from DRA and the Town as to any need for the board to retain jurisdiction pursuant to RSA 76:16 and 17 during the 2006 update process.
