ORDER

This “Order” relates to the proposed protective order (“Protective Order”) agreed to by the parties which was attached to the October 7, 2010 letter from Jonathan A. Block, Esq., counsel for the “Taxpayer.” The board held a limited hearing on December 16, 2010 relative to the need for the Protective Order and what documents were to be protected.

At the limited hearing, Attorney Block, at the request of the board, indicated he would submit a summary of the documents he was submitting to the “Town” and the justification for them being confidential documents subject to the provisions of the Protective Order. In a December 21, 2010 letter, Attorney Block itemized various Taxpayer documents that he felt were confidential and should be protected.

The board approves the Protective Order, but at this time, limits the documents subject to the Protective Order to those identified in the December 21, 2010 letter.

To the extent the Town has any documents that it may wish to be similarly protected, it may submit its own list of itemized documents for the board's review.
