ORDER

The board has reviewed Mr. Mudge's September 7, 2012 "Request for Clarification and Confirmation" (the "Request") and the September 14, 2012 "Response" filed by the "Town." The suspension order entered by the board on September 12, 2012 is hereby dissolved.

The Response states the Town "has no objection" to the Request insofar as it seeks to "make sure that the Lead Petitioner Mr. Mudge receives copies of all documents submitted by the Town in response to" the August 31, 2012 Order. The Town further indicates its "understanding and intent" to send "Mr. Mudge as lead Petitioner" copies of whatever documents the Town files with the board in response to the Order. Consequently, the Request is moot and requires no board action at this time.
