

Options for Tax Refunds

If you received a BIG tax refund you might consider adjusting your W-4 to receive more money each week, versus a big check each year in April. This <u>document from the IRS</u> explains how to check and adjust your withholding. Once this adjustment is made you'll have some extra money to deposit into a share or savings account to pay for emergencies, new clothes, vacations, even retirement. If you have kids, you could also add to a 529 College Savings Plan. Save up now, you'll thank yourself later.

If you haven't filed your taxes, you still have time (April 17th is the deadline this year). If you need help, please call 211 to find a VITA or AARP Tax Prep Site in NH. Residents may qualify for the <u>Earned Income Tax Credit</u>, the <u>Child Tax Credit</u>, or the <u>Savers Tax Credit</u>.
