SUNAPEE-NEW LONDON PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
8.3 MILES OF GUARDRAIL REPLACEMENT ON NH 11 AND I-89

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a combined Town Officials/Public Informational Meeting will be held Tuesday, February 22, 2005 to discuss the planned replacement of guardrail on NH Route 11 in Sunapee and New London, and Interstate 89 in Lebanon.

This project begins on NH 11, from the intersection of NH Route 103 in Sunapee and runs northeast approximately 7 miles to I-89 (Exit 12) in New London. It also includes I-89 northbound in Lebanon between exits 19 and 20 for approximately 1.3 miles.

The purpose of this meeting is to present citizens and town officials with information regarding the proposed project, and to solicit input in order to ensure that project decisions meet public transportation needs and community goals, and protect and enhance the environment.

The February 22 public meeting will be held at the Sunapee Town Hall, 23 Edgemont Road in Sunapee, New Hampshire. It will begin at 7:00 pm and be followed by a question and comment period.
