NIGHTTIME PAVING WORK ON I-293 IN MANCHESTER
ALL FOUR EXIT 4 RAMPS OVER FOUR NIGHTS

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces nighttime paving work will begin Sunday, September 30, 2007 on the I-293/Everett Turnpike Exit 4 ramps in Manchester.

This project will involve asphalt grinding and new pavement on all four ramps. The ramps will be closed one at a time over four nights to complete the work. Nightly work hours will be between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM.

Brox Industries, Inc. of Dracut, Massachusetts is the contractor for this work, which is part of a larger resurfacing project that is paving segments of the Everett Turnpike and Interstate 293 between Nashua and Hooksett. The total project contract is approximately \$1.4 million.
