**LOUDON-BELMONT PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING**  
***REHABILITATION OF 7.7 MILES OF NH ROUTE 106***

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a combined Public Officials/Public Informational Meeting will be held Wednesday, February 27, 2008 to discuss the pavement rehabilitation of 7.7 miles on NH Route 106 in Loudon and Belmont.

This Federal Resurfacing Program project, which includes drainage improvements and guardrail replacement, begins 3,000 feet south of Asby Road in Loudon and proceeds north to Perkins Road in Belmont.

Also included within this project is the State-funded reconstruction and signalization of the intersection of NH Route 140. Public meetings were previously held for this work.

The purpose of this meeting is to present citizens and public officials with information regarding the proposed project, and to solicit input in order to ensure that project decisions meet public transportation needs, community goals, and protect and enhance the environment.

The February 27 public meeting will be held at 7:00 PM at the Belmont Corner Meeting House, 16 Sargent Street, in Belmont, New Hampshire.
