HOOKSETT PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
IMPROVEMENTS TO 4/10 MILE OF US 3/NH 28

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) announces a Public Informational Meeting has been scheduled to discuss the reconstruction and improvements to a section of US Route 3/NH Route 28 in Hooksett.

This project begins on US 3/NH 28 at the Benton Road/Clough Avenue intersection and proceeds south approximately 4/10 of a mile to the Whitehall Road (NH Route 27)/Martin's Ferry Road intersection. The meeting will also discuss the replacing of culverts conveying Dalton Brook beneath NH Route 28 Bypass and US Route 3.

The public meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 12, 2008 at 7:00 PM at the Hooksett Public Library, Main Building #2, 1701B Hooksett Road, Hooksett, NH.

This purpose of this meeting is to present citizens and public officials with information regarding the proposed project, and to solicit public input in order to ensure that project decisions meet public transportation needs, community goals, and protect and enhance the environment. Accordingly, the NHDOT assures that this project will be administered according to the requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related statutes to ensure nondiscrimination.
