

Position Title	Responsibilities

Assistant Administrator	Role: EMS team leader. Responsibilities: EMS implementation, progress tracking, reporting, training, documentation. Knowledgeable of entire Bureau EMS program. Coordinate annual management review. Accountable to: Bureau Administrator for EMS implementation.
District Engineer	Role: Overall responsibility and accountability for EMS program at the District level. Responsibilities: Legal and Regulatory compliance, and environmental performance within the District. Selection of District representatives on the Bureau EMS management team. Knowledgeable of entire Bureau EMS program. Participate in annual management review. Accountable to: Bureau Administrator.
Assistant District Engineer	Role: Implementation of EMS in the District as determined by the District Engineer. Participate in EMS management team as determined by District Engineer. Responsibilities: Development, implementation, training, and record keeping for EMS within the District as determined by the District Engineer. Knowledgeable of entire Bureau EMS program. Participate in annual management review as determined by District Engineer. Accountable to: District Engineer.
Safety and Environmental Coordinator	Role: Implementation of EMS in the District as determined by the District Engineer. Participate in EMS Management team as determined by District Engineer. Responsibilities: Development, implementation, training, and record keeping for EMS within the District as determined by the District Engineer. Knowledgeable of entire Bureau EMS program. Participate in annual management review. Accountable to: District Engineer.
Maintenance Supervisor	Role: EMS Coordination Responsibility: EMS training and implementation. Assist in Training of vendors, contractors, and district staff. Report EMS related issues to District EMS team members. Knowledgeable of entire Bureau EMS program. Accountable to: District Engineer
