**WHEREAS**, Community Transportation services address the transportation needs of a community and are vital to New Hampshire citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Transportation services are important for older adults, people with disabilities, individuals with limited income and the public at large; and

**WHEREAS**, Community transportation is imperative to New Hampshire's economy, bringing employees to their jobs, customers to businesses and other commercial establishments, while increasing access to education and helping to improve the environment; and

**WHEREAS**, Many current riders depend upon existing services to maintain their independence and to contribute to their communities; and

**WHEREAS**, Community transportation plays an important role in making cities and towns vibrant places to live by increasing mobility and quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, Current demographic trends indicate that the demand for community transportation is likely to significantly increase in the near future; and

**WHEREAS**, The State Coordinating Council for Community Transportation is leading the effort to address community transportation needs across the state;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN H. LYNCH, GOVERNOR** of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim **NOVEMBER 18, 2010** as **COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION DAY** in New Hampshire and urge all citizens to recognize the importance of community transportation in our economy.
