BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN PROJECT WORK TO RESUME IN LEBANON
TREE CLEARING ALONG HEATER ROAD AND MOUNT SUPPORT ROAD

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces the resumption of work on the construction of roadway improvements to accommodate bicycles and pedestrians on Heater Road and Mount Support Road in Lebanon.

Work is expected to resume the week of February 14, 2005 with tree clearing along Heater Road and Mount Support Road. It's anticipated that the tree clearing work will take approximately one week to complete.

One-way alternating traffic will be necessary on Heater Road and Mount Support Road in order to complete the work. Advanced signing will notify motorists of the lane closures. Uniformed officers and flaggers will help guide motorists through the work zones. Motorists are encouraged to take alternative routes, if possible.

United Construction Corporation of Newport, NH is the contractor for the \$1.3 million project.
