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TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGES ON MANCHESTER I-293 PROJECT
ROAD AND BRIDGE REHABILITATION WORK

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces traffic pattern changes are planned on I-293/NH 101 westbound in Manchester in the area of Exit 1 (South Willow Street) on Tuesday, April 26 and Wednesday, April 27. Motorists should anticipate delays at various times throughout each day.

There will also be potential traffic delays on Thursday, April 28 and Friday, April 29 on eastbound I-293/NH 101 from the Merrimack River to Exit 1 (South Willow Street) due to lane closures associated with survey work.

This project involves bridge and pavement rehabilitation and the widening of a section of I-293 in Manchester from two to three lanes from west of the South Willow Street Bridge over I-293 east to the interchange with I-93. Continental Paving of Londonderry, New Hampshire is the general contractor for the \$8.3 million project, which has a scheduled completion date of September 2005.
