TEMPORARY CLOSURE PLANNED FOR I-93 RAMP IN MANCHESTER
NORTHBOUND EXIT 6 OFF-RAMP AT CANDIA ROAD ON 10/11

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a six-hour closure is planned for the Interstate 93 Exit 6 northbound off-ramp at Candia Road in Manchester on Saturday, October 11, 2008 to allow for paving work to be completed.

This ramp closure will be in effect from 6:00 am until noontime on October 11. Motorists are advised to seek alternative routes.

This project has involved road and bridge rehabilitation work on I-93 in Manchester from I-293 north for two miles to Exit 7, and has included the rehabilitation of the northbound and southbound bridges over Hanover Street and Candia Road. It has also included work in pavement rehabilitation work on I-293 in Bedford from the Everett Turnpike to the Merrimack River Bridge, and NH 101 between Kilton Road and NH 114.

Brox Industries, Inc. of Dracut, Massachusetts is the contractor for the \$3.9 million project, which is scheduled to be completed by October 21, 2008.
