BLASTING WORK TO BEGIN AT EXIT 3 OF I-93 IN WINDHAM
SOME TRAFFIC DELAYS WITH “ROLLING ROAD BLOCKS”

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces blasting work associated with the construction of the new Exit 3 southbound off ramp from Interstate I-93 in Windham will begin the week of December 1, 2008.

Some of this blasting work will require traffic on I-93 to be delayed by “rolling roadblocks”. Speeds will be reduced by using State Police cruisers to slow down traffic on I-93 at either approach to the blasting zone. These periodic rolling roadblocks will take place during the non-commuter hours of 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM through April 2009. Minor traffic delays can be expected.

This work is part of the construction of a new I-93 southbound off ramp at Exit 3 on a new alignment. Middlesex Corporation of Littleton, Massachusetts is the general contractor for the \$25 million project, which is scheduled for completion in June 2010.
