WORK BEGINNING ON EXPANSION OF NEW LONDON PARK AND RIDE
87 SPACES BEING ADDED TO LOCATION JUST OFF EXIT 12 OF I-89

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces the beginning of construction work on the expansion of the New London Park and Ride on NH Route 103A just off Exit 12 of Interstate 89.

This project will expand the current intermodal Park and Ride facility from 45 parking spaces to 132 spaces. It will also improve pedestrian and handicap accessibility, and provide a concrete pad for motorcycles.

During this construction period, the existing level of parking spaces at the Park and Ride will be maintained. Future notices will alert users to the paving of the existing portion of the facility.

John H. Lyman and Sons, Inc. of Gilford, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$295,000 project, which is scheduled to be completed in late June 2009.
