BRIDGE BEAM SETTING ON I-93 NORTHBOUND AT EXIT 5 IN LONDONDERRY
NIGHTTIME LANE CLOSURE ON MONDAY AUGUST 17

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces structural concrete beams will be set on the new I-93 northbound on-ramp bridge at Exit 5 in Londonderry over a recreational trail on Monday, August 17, 2009. In the event of inclement weather, this work will take place the following night.

The bridge work is expected to start at 9:00 PM and be completed by 6:00 AM the following morning and will require a lane reduction along I-93 NB in the area of Exit 5.

Message boards and signs will alert traffic to the work zone. Uniformed officers will slow traffic on I-93 as needed. Minor traffic delays can be expected.

This project, which began in July 2008, is part of the reconfiguration of the Exit 5 southbound on and off ramps, and the northbound on-ramp, including two new ramp bridges over a recreational trail. The project is part of the Salem to Manchester I-93 expansion project.

Severino Trucking Co., Inc. of Candia, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$14.9 million project, which is scheduled to be completed November 2009.
