**PLYMOUTH-HOLDERNESS NH ROUTE 175A  
BRIDGE CLOSURE EXTENDED TO FOUR DAYS**

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces the closure of the NH Route 175A bridge over the Pemigewasset River in Plymouth-Holderness has been extended to four days, from Tuesday, September 7 through Friday, September 10, 2004. The closure was previously announced as lasting two days.

This bridge and road closures are necessary to perform work associated with underground gasoline recovery and containment in the area of the bridge.

NH Route 175A is closed to through traffic at the bridge from 7:00 am on September 7 until 5:00 pm on September 10. Detour signs will advise motorists to access downtown Plymouth via Exit 26 on Interstate 93.

This \$1.5 million project involves utility relocation and gasoline recovery and containment. Winterset, Inc. of Lyndonville, Vermont is the general contractor for the project, which has a completion date of October 1, 2004.
