**WORK RESUMES ON NH ROUTE 11 IN ANDOVER AND FRANKLIN**  
***REHABILITATION OF A TOTAL OF 3.8 MILES OF HIGHWAY***

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces work has resumed this week on the reconstruction of 2.3 miles of NH Route 11 from Hoyt Road in Andover to Log Cabin Road in Franklin.

Motorists should expect occasional one-way alternating traffic during work hours. Weaver Brothers Construction of Bow, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$3 million project, which has a completion date of November 2005.

This project abuts an ongoing road reconstruction project on NH 11 that involves 1.5 miles in Franklin from Log Cabin Road to NH Route 3A. Included in this project are some road alignment and grade adjustments near Webster Lake, a new intersection at Chance Pond Road, and a new "T Type" intersection at Route 3A.

R.D. Edmunds of Franklin, New Hampshire is the contractor for this \$2.5 million project, which also has a November 2005 completion date.
