PAVING WORK ON I-293 EASTBOUND IN MANCHESTER
BETWEEN THE I-93 SPLIT AND THE MERRIMACK RIVER

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces paving work is scheduled to begin this Friday night (June 24) on Interstate 293 in Manchester.

Initial work, between 9:00 pm on June 24 and 10:00 am on Saturday, June 25, will involve pavement grinding on I-293 eastbound between the Merrimack River to just beyond Brown Avenue, and including the Brown Avenue ramps.

Paving will begin Sunday, June 26, at 9:00 pm and will continue daily until Thursday, June 30. This new paving work will extend from Merrimack River to just beyond the I-293/I-93 split.

Two lanes of shifted traffic will be maintained during this paving project. Uniformed officers will be used to guide motorists through the work zone.

Continental Paving, of Londonderry, New Hampshire is the contractor for the road reconstruction project, which has a final completion date of September 2005.
