EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO A SECTION OF NH ROUTE 4A IN ENFIELD
WILL REQUIRE A ROAD CLOSURE FOR UP TO TWO WEEKS

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces emergency repair work on a section of NH Route 4A in Enfield will require a two week road closure, beginning the week of September 26, 2005.

This project is necessary due to pavement failure on a 300-foot section of NH 4A west of Shaker Village and next to Mascoma Lake. During the repair work, this section of NH Route 4A will be closed to through traffic. It will be open to local traffic west of the project location. Traffic approaching from the east on NH 4A will be detoured via Shaker Hill Road to US Route 4.

SCI of Newport, Vermont is the contractor for the project.
