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ONE MORE DETOUR FOR I-89 LEDGE REMOVAL IN SUTTON
NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC WILL GET OFF AT EXIT 9 AND ON AT EXIT 10

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces ledge blasting work on Interstate 89 in Sutton will require one more anticipated northbound detour on Wednesday, September 28, 2005.

Beginning after 8:30 am on September 28, northbound traffic on I-89 will be detoured off at Exit 9 and then back on at Exit 10 via NH Routes 103 and 114. Variable message boards will alert motorists to the detour.

This project involves ledge removal and slope stabilization in the median of I-89 in Sutton. Weaver Brothers Inc. of Bow, New Hampshire is the general contractor for the \$1.6 million project.
