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**SHATTUCK WAY TO OPEN TO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC IN NEWINGTON  
WILL RESULT IN PERMANENT CLOSURE OF EXIT 4N ON SPAULDING TURNPIKE**

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces Shattuck Way in Newington will be opened to two-way traffic on Thursday, November 10, 2005.

However, one lane of alternating traffic may still be required on Shattuck Way during the day until the project is completed. Message boards, cones and barrels will guide motorists through the work zone.

Also, Exit 4N on the Spaulding Turnpike will be closed permanently during the week of November 21.

This project involves rebuilding the Spaulding Turnpike Exit 4 approaches and southbound ramps to Nimble Hill Road and northbound ramps to Shattuck Way. It also eliminates a median turnaround and converts Shattuck Way from a one-way road to a two-way road. The existing southbound on-ramp is being eliminated, and the south-to-north reverse direction ramp in the Turnpike median will be available for emergency use only.

SUR Construction of Rochester, New Hampshire is the prime contractor for the \$4 million project, which has a final completion date of July 2006.
