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ALLENSTOWN-PEMBROKE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT ON US ROUTE 3
SOUTHBOUND ON-RAMP FROM TURNPIKE STREET TO BE CLOSED

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces the planned closure on Monday, December 5, 2005 of the southbound on-ramp to Route 3 from Turnpike Street in Pembroke as part of the double-decker bridge replacement project on US Route 3 over the Suncook River at the Allenstown-Pembroke town line..

The ramp closure to allow for the relocation of a water main and the bridge replacement will be in effect for 18 months. The detour to access Route 3 southbound will be via Turnpike Street and Main Street.

Audley Construction of Bow, New Hampshire is the prime contractor for the \$11.4 million bridge replacement and road reconstruction project, which has a final completion date of October 2007.
