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**OVERHEAD SIGN WORK ON I-93 FROM HOOKSETT TO CONCORD**  
**INSTALLATION OF SEVEN STRUCTURES WILL REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES**

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces overhead sign replacement work will begin the week of Monday, January 16, 2006 on Interstate 93 (also the F.E. Everett Turnpike) from the Hooksett Tolls to Exit 14 in Concord.

This project will involve the replacement of six overhead sign structures and the installation of one new one. It will include some night work and will require occasional lane closures.

Liddell Brothers, of Halifax, Massachusetts is the contractor for the \$700,000 project, which is scheduled to be completed this April.
