STRATHAM-EPPING-LEE PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
PLANNED WORK ON NH 33, NH 125, AND NH 152

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a combined Public Officials/Public Informational Meeting will be held Wednesday, April 5, 2006 to discuss planned improvements on NH Route 33, NH 125 and NH 152

This work encompasses two projects. One is paving, drainage improvements and guardrail replacement on NH Route 33, beginning at the intersection of NH 108 in Stratham and proceeding east two miles to the New Hampshire Technical Institute; and NH Route 125 from NH 87 in Epping north 3.1 miles to north of NH 152 in Lee. The second project is on NH 152 in Lee and involves realigning High Street further west to improve the intersection with NH 125.

The purpose of this meeting is to present citizens and public officials with information regarding the proposed project, and to solicit input in order to ensure that project decisions meet public transportation needs and community goals, and protect and enhance the environment.

The April 5 public meeting will be held at the Lee Town Hall, 7 Mast Road in Lee, New Hampshire, beginning at 7:00 pm.
