ROUNDBOUT CONSTRUCTION WORK BEGINS IN KEENE
INTERSECTION OF NH ROUTES 10/12/101 AT WINCHESTER STREET

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces work is scheduled to get underway this week on the construction of a two-lane roundabout at the intersection of NH Routes 10, 12 and 101 and Winchester Street in Keene.

This project begins on NH 101, approximately 1/3 of a mile west of the Winchester Street intersection and continues east 5/8 of a mile to the abandoned railroad corridor. It also includes work on NH Route 10, beginning just north of Fairbanks Street and continuing north 1/3 of a mile to the Key Road intersection with Winchester Street.

Work this winter will be limited to soil removal and drainage extensions in the intersection area. Most of the roundabout construction will take place during the 2007 construction season.

No lane closures are planned between the hours of 6:00 am and 7:00 pm from Monday through Saturday. Most construction activities will take place between the hours of 7:00 pm and 6:00 am. Electronic message boards will be used to advise motorists of work in the area.

Park Construction Corporation of Fitzwilliam, New Hampshire is the general contractor for the \$6.4 million project, which has a final completion date of August 2008.
