INTERSTATE 293 BRIDGE REPAIRS PLANNED IN MANCHESTER
SOUTHBOUND BRIDGE OVER STARKWAY ROAD FOR ONE WEEK

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces bridge maintenance work is scheduled to begin Monday, January 8, 2007 on the Interstate 293 southbound bridge over Starkway Road in Manchester. This bridge is located between Exit 7 and Exit 6.

This bridge work will include some widening, new curbing and bridge rail repair. Daily work hours will be from 9:00 am until 3:30 pm and is expected to take one week to complete. It will require lane closures on I-293 southbound and Stark Way will be closed during daytime hours at the I-293 Bridge.

Motorists seeking to access Starkway Road will be detoured via Stark Lane to Front Street (NH 3A). Motorists on I-293 southbound will be guided through the work zone by warning signs, cones and uniformed officers.
