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WORK RESUMES ON US 202/NH 9 REHABILITATION IN HILLSBOROUGH-HENNIKER
INCLUDES CENTERLINE AND EDGE LINE RUMBLE STRIPS FOR 12 MILES

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces work is scheduled to resume on Monday, June 25, 2007 on a pavement rehabilitation project on 4.5 miles of US Route 202/NH Route 9 in Hillsborough and Henniker.

Still to be completed on the project are centerline and edge line rumble strips on approximately 12 miles of US 202/NH 9 in Hopkinton, Henniker and Hillsborough, from Exit 5 on Interstate 89 to near the beginning of the Hillsborough Bypass. Additional work to be completed includes the removal of a detour and construction of an emergency access road.

Lane closures will be necessary for some of the remaining work, including the rumble strip grinding.

Pike Industries, Inc. of Belmont, New Hampshire is the general contractor for the \$3.3 million project, which is scheduled to be completed by late July 2007.

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
