HAMPTON FALLS-HAMPTON PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
REPLACEMENT OF THE I-95 BRIDGE OVER TAYLOR RIVER

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a Public Informational Meeting will be held Monday, October 29, 2007 in Hampton Falls to receive input on a Draft Feasibility Study to replace the bridge that carries I-95 over the Taylor River, and the replacement or removal of the Taylor River Dam.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for an informal discussion and exchange of ideas on the Draft Feasibility Study that reviews the bridge replacement options, and the replacement or removal options for the Taylor River dam.
