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ROAD AND BRIDGE PROJECT TO RESUME IN CLAREMONT-NEWPORT
RECONSTRUCTION OF 3.8 MILES OF NH ROUTE 11/103

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces road and bridge work is scheduled to resume on Monday April 7, 2008 in Claremont and Newport on NH Route 11/103.

This project involves road reconstruction and pavement widening, as well as the replacement of the NH Route 11/103 bridge over Ram Brook in Newport.

Two-way traffic will be maintained on temporary pavement with alternating one-way traffic on occasion between 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Traffic flow will be controlled by flaggers and/or uniformed officers as needed.

Motorist should use caution while driving in a construction zone and should allow more time to reach their destination during work hours.

R.S. Audley, Inc. of Bow, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$12.2 million project. The final completion is scheduled for September 5, 2008.

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
