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FINAL PAVING WORK ON CANDIA ROAD PROJECT IN MANCHESTER
FROM PROCTOR ROAD TO I-93 EXIT 6 OFF RAMP INTERCHANGE

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces final paving work is scheduled to take place on Saturday, May 17, 2008 on a section of Candia Road in Manchester from Proctor Road to the I-93 Exit 6 off ramp interchange. Weather permitting, this paving work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.

Flaggers and uniformed officers will assist with traffic control. Occasional one-way alternating traffic will occur and motorists should anticipate delays of up to ten minutes. The Exit 6 off ramp will remain open, however motorists may be delayed or not allowed to go westbound on Candia Road during certain time periods. Alternate routes are strongly encouraged if possible.

All other remaining work, including striping, drives, and signs, should have only minor traffic impacts and is scheduled to be completed by late spring.

This project has involved the reconstruction and widening of Candia Road from the I-93/Exit 6 eastern ramp to the Massabesic Circle. It has included intersection improvements at Industrial Park Drive, Hanover Street, Bridge Street, and other minor intersection work at 11 additional intersections. Also included in the project have been drainage improvements, traffic signal upgrades, and sewer and water system work.

R.S. Audley, Inc. of Bow, New Hampshire is the general contractor for the \$8.7 million project. Continental Paving of Londonderry, New Hampshire is the subcontractor performing the paving work.

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
