**NIGHT LANE CLOSURES PLANNED ON I-93 AT EXIT 1 IN SALEM
TO ALLOW FOR THE DEMOLITION OF TWO BRIDGES OVER THE INTERSTATE**

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces night bridge demolition work is scheduled to get underway on Interstate 93 at Exit 1 in Salem.

Work is set to begin on Sunday night, June 8, on I-93 northbound. This activity will require lane closures as well as traffic shutdowns of 10 to 15 minutes twice each hour. The northbound work will take place between 8:30 pm and 7:30 am on Sunday through Thursday nights.

Bridge demolition work on I-93 southbound will begin on Monday night, June 9, and will also require lane closures and traffic shutdowns of 10 to 15 minutes twice each hour. The southbound work will occur between 7:30 pm and 5:00 am on Monday through Friday nights.

This work will take about a week to perform and is weather dependent. Uniformed officers, message boards, signs and traffic control devices will be used to direct and guide traffic through the work zone. Motorists are advised to plan for delays.

This work is part of the \$22.2 million I-93 Exit 1 rebuilding project. The general contractor is SPS New England, Inc. of Salisbury, Massachusetts.
