BERLIN PROJECT AGAIN REQUIRING GREEN STREET CLOSURE
SIX WEEK SIGNED DETOUR ALONG EXISTING TRUCK ROUTE

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces the planned closure of a section of Green Street in Berlin, beginning the week of April 14, 2007.

Similar to a previous 18-month closure, Green Street will be closed to through traffic from Cole Street to First Avenue for a period of six weeks to allow for utility work. A signed detour during the road closure will follow the existing truck route via Mt. Forist Street and First Avenue.

R.M. Piper of Plymouth, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$4.39 million project, which includes the reconstruction of Green Street from Pleasant Street to Second Avenue, along with drainage and water main work. The project is scheduled to be completed this summer.
