NEW CROSS STREET BRIDGE OVER I-93 IN SALEM TO OPEN
FIRST COMPLETION MILESTONE FOR I-93 REBUILDING PROJECT

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) announces the new Cross Street Bridge over Interstate 93 in Concord will be opened to traffic on Thursday, August 21, 2008. This new bridge replaces a Red List Bridge built in 1961 and is the first bridge completed as part of the I-93 rebuilding project.

Demolition on the old Cross Street Bridge will begin the night of Monday, August 25. This night work will take place between 8:00 PM and 6:00 AM and will require northbound and southbound lane closures on I-93 for approximately three weeks. Uniformed officers, signs and traffic cones or barrels will be used to direct and guide motorists through the work zone.

R.S. Audley, Inc. of Bow, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$6.65 million project, which has a final completion date of October 2008.
