BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT ON NH ROUTE 1A IN RYE
DETOUR AROUND SEAVEY CREEK TO BEGIN ON 11/3

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces work is getting underway on the replacement of the NH Route 1A bridge over Seavey Creek in Rye. This is a State Red List Bridge that was built in 1943.

This project will require a detour that will begin on Monday, November 3, 2008. The detour will utilize Bracket Road and Marsh Road to redirect traffic around the bridge work area. The new bridge and roadway will be reopened to traffic by May 15, 2009. The final completion date for the project is June 12, 2009.

Reed and Reed Inc. of Woolrich, Maine is the prime contractor for the \$2.04 million project.
