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NEW I-93 EXIT 1 RAMPS AND BRIDGES TO OPEN IN SALEM
EXIT 1 TRAFFIC SHIFT REACHES CONTRACT MILESTONE

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces the new I-93 Exit 1 Ramp Bridges in Salem will be open to traffic, weather dependant, beginning Wednesday November 19, 2008.

The construction of a significant portion of the Exit 1 project was accelerated in order to shift the traffic onto three newly constructed bridges before the winter maintenance season begins. Over the next several days the ramp traffic will be guided through this busy work zone using lane closures, shoulder closures and uniformed officers.

SPS New England, Inc. of Salisbury, MA is the contractor for the \$22.8 million Exit 1 ramps and bridges replacement project, which is scheduled for completion in October 2009.

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
