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RAMP TRAFFIC SHIFTS AT INTERSTATE 93 EXIT 1 IN SALEM
RAMP AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION FOR I-93 EXIT 1, NB & SB ON-RAMPS

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a traffic shift is scheduled to take place on Friday, June 5, on the Interstate 93 Exit 1 northbound and southbound on-ramps in Salem. Weather dependent, this work will take place throughout the day on Friday and will continue into the night and be completed before 4:00 am Saturday, June 6.

On June 5, motorists using the ramps to Interstate 93 northbound and southbound at Exit 1 can expect a lane closure with possible minor traffic delays. Beginning at approximately 10:00 pm, the I-93 northbound on-ramp will be closed temporarily for up to four hours in order to complete the construction of the temporary ramp.

During the ramp closure, motorists will be advised to follow a detour south into Massachusetts and reverse direction at I-93 Exit 47 (Pelham Street). Uniformed officers and traffic control devices will be used to assist motorists through the work zone.

This work is part of the \$22.3 million I-93 Exit 1 rebuilding project. The general contractor is SPS New England, Inc. of Salisbury, Massachusetts.

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
