**NH ROUTE 127 IN HOPKINTON REOPENED TO TRAFFIC**  
***CLOSED SINCE JANUARY 30 FOR A DECK REPLACEMENT***

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces the NH Route 127 in Hopkinton is reopened to traffic. The 275-foot long bridge has been closed since January 30 for a bridge deck replacement project.

The two-lane, steel girder bridge over a spillway channel is located on NH 127, about one-half mile from I-89 between Exit 6 and NH 202/9. The replacement of the 50-year old bridge deck, which was originally to be completed by June 26, was finished ahead of schedule.

Minor work remains on the bridge project and is not expected to impact traffic. Part of the contract includes the resurfacing some Hopkinton town roads, which should begin in about two weeks.

R.S. Audley Inc. of Bow, New Hampshire is the prime contractor for the \$1.1 million project.
