INTERSTATE 89 NORTHBOUND REMAINS CLOSED IN WARNER
REPAIR WORK CONTINUES TOWARDS A PLANNED TUESDAY REOPENING

Work continues around the clock to replace a failed drainage pipe and to reopen a section of Interstate 89 northbound in Warner that has been closed to traffic since Saturday evening.

State Police closed I-89 northbound between Exit 7 and Exit 9 after a sinkhole was discovered. Northbound traffic on I-89 continues to be detoured off at Exit 7 and back on at Exit 9.

Major excavation work has been necessary to replace a failed 30-inch drainage pipe, which was approximately 25 feet below the road surface. The affected northbound lanes of I-89 are expected to be repaved and reopened to traffic by late Tuesday.
