**NIGHT PAVING WORK ON I-293/F. E. EVERETT TURNPIKE IN MANCHESTER/
HOOKSETT**

COLD PLANING AND PAVING WORK TO BE DONE OVERNIGHT

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces night work will begin on Sunday, August 23, on I-293/F.E. Everett Turnpike between the Notre Dame Bridge in Manchester and the merge with I-93 in Hooksett. Colding planing and paving operations will be performed on both the Northbound and Southbound travel ways.

Weather dependent, this work will take place between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Motorists using this roadway can expect lane closures with minor traffic delays. Uniformed officers and traffic control devices will be used to assist motorists through the work zones. It is anticipated that this work will take approximately two weeks to complete.

This work is part of a \$1.88 million resurfacing project. The general contractor is Continental Paving, Inc. of Londonderry, New Hampshire.
