Dear Sir/Madame:

The Department of Transportation and the AGC of New Hampshire have been working to implement an electronic bidding solution for NH construction contracts to replace the current paper bid process. Beginning in January 2016 and commencing a transition period, the Department of Transportation will be offering prequalified Contractors the opportunity to submit electronic bids on selected contracts. Each contract where electronic bids will be accepted will be denoted in the *Invitations for Bids*. During the transition period the bidder will have the option of submitting paper or electronic bids.

Electronic bidding has many benefits, including reduced travel, printing, and bidding expense.

To help in this transition, the Department will be offering free training to all prequalified Contractors on how to submit electronic bids. This training will be offered during the week of December 15-18, 2015. The training will be held at NHDOT in Concord and will last approximately 2 hours. Please sign-up for this training through the DOT Contracts Office.
