Oversize/Overweight Permitting

2017 Seasonal Program

Saturday Moves

Under a program that will begin on Saturday April 8, 2017 and end on Saturday November 18, 2017, New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) will issue oversize/overweight (OS/OW) permits to allow movement on Saturday mornings from ½ hour before sunrise until noon. Saturday moves on I-95 will be further limited from ½ hour before sunrise to 9:00 AM beginning July 1, 2017 and ending on August 26, 2017. OS/OW permits will be issued in accordance with current permit processing procedures. To order Saturday permits on the OverHaul permit system, applicants must type "SATURDAY TRAVEL REQUESTED" in the carrier comments field and "SATURDAY" in the serial number field in the OverHaul application. Applications for Saturday moves must be submitted by at least the close of business on Thursday prior to the Saturday move date.

NHDOT and New Hampshire Department of Safety (NHDOS) will continue to conduct a review of this program during and at the end of the seasonal program period to determine whether Saturday permitting should continue and/or if modifications to the seasonal program are required.

Escort requirements will be in accordance with current permit processing procedures. All other conditions on the permit will remain in effect for the duration of the permitted move. **Saturday moves will not be allowed during holiday weekends.**

Existing limitations on manufactured housing moves greater than 14 feet in width will not be changed by this program. In addition, existing limitations on New England Transportation Consortium (NETC) permits will not be changed by this program.
