

**SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATION****AMENDMENT TO SECTION 107 – LEGAL RELATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITY TO PUBLIC**

*The purpose of this Supplemental Specification is to revise wording pertaining to discharge and spillage into water.*

**Amend** 107.01 7<sup>th</sup> paragraph to read:

Projects in this State occur within watersheds under the management of the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Water Division (WD). The purpose of part Env-Ws 1700 of the NH Code of Administrative Rules is to “establish water quality standards for the State’s surface water uses as set forth in RSA 485-A.” **The Contractor’s attention is further called to RSA 146-A Oil Discharge or Spillage in Surface Water or Groundwater.** The Contractor must take sufficient precautions to prevent the runoff of fuels, oils, bitumens, calcium chloride, or other polluting materials, harmful to humans, fish, or other life, into the water supplies and surface waters of the State. **The Contractor shall have oil spill kits on site and readily available during construction.**
