Qualified Products List – Qualification Criteria

Section 632 – Retroreflective Pavement Markings - Temporary Tapes

- A. ITEM 632.1 – PREFORMED RETROREFLECTIVE TAPE, TYPE I (REMOVABLE)**
- B. ITEM 632.2 – PREFORMED RETROREFLECTIVE TAPE, TYPE II (NON-REMOVABLE)**
- F. ITEM 632.9 – PREFORMED BLACKOUT TAPE, TYPE I (REMOVABLE)**

Specification

Temporary Pavement Marking Tape and Blackout Tape shall conform to the applicable sections of ASTM D4592 and have a minimum thickness of 25 mils as outlined in the Departments Standard Specification section 632.

Required Submissions

QPL Product Submittal Form

The submitted form must be completely filled out and must be the current version of the form. The QPL Product Submittal Form can be obtained at www.nh.gov/dot/research.

Product Literature

Submit any product literature, including NTPEP product information that is relevant to evaluation of the product.

MSDS

Provide complete Material Safety Data Sheets for the submitted product.

Qualification Criteria

- Laboratory and field results obtained by the AASHTO NTPEP will be used in the evaluation of this material. Temporary Pavement Marking Tape that has not been tested through NTPEP will be rejected.
- Products are added or deleted from this list based on three years of performance data from AASHTO's National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP) for Pavement Marking Materials.
- NTPEP laboratory results will be used to determine conformance to NHDOT Standard Specification Section 632.
- The Temporary Pavement Marking Tape shall not contain metallic foil.
- The Temporary Pavement Marking Tape shall have a pressure-sensitive adhesive.
- The Department must be notified in writing of any change in product formulation. Significant changes may require reevaluation of the product.
- Products may be removed from the list for poor field performance in New Hampshire regardless of the rating obtained through NTPEP.
