LACONIA PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
REHABILITATION OF US 3 BRIDGE BY WEIRS BEACH

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) announces a Public Informational Meeting has been scheduled to address the involvement of the rehabilitation of the “Red List” bridge that carries US Route 3 over the NH Railroad by Weirs Beach in Laconia. This project is in the vicinity of wetlands and historic properties.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 23, 2015, with the doors opening at 6:30 and the presentation at 7:00 pm in room 200A at the Laconia City Hall, 45 Beacon Street East, in Laconia, New Hampshire.

The purpose of this meeting is to present citizens and public officials with information regarding the proposed project. The meeting is also to solicit public input in order to ensure that project decisions meet public transportation needs, community goals, and protect and enhance the environment. Accordingly, the NHDOT assures this project will be administered according to the requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related statutes to ensure nondiscrimination.
