It is anticipated that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will fund approximately \$5M in Airport Improvement Projects in New Hampshire as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

To date, the projects have not been confirmed. This website will be updated as the projects are announced.

The following were projects that were requested:

1. Installation of an Instrument Landing System at the Mt. Washington Regional Airport, Whitefield NH.
2. Dillant –Hopkins (Keene)- airport terminal apron rehabilitation
3. Mt. Washington Regional Airport (Whitefield)-snow removal equipment building
4. Mt. Washington Regional Airport (Whitefield)-apron reconstruction and taxiway construction
5. Laconia Municipal Airport-terminal apron reconstruction
6. Boire Field (Nashua)- reconstruct terminal apron
7. Lebanon Airport -construct aircraft fire and rescue building and snow removal building
8. Portsmouth International Airport at Pease- purchase snow removal equipment
9. Manchester-Boston Regional Airport
 - Terminal & Building Improvements
 - Equipment Purchase
 - Airside Improvements
 - Public Safety
