SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

This Settlement Agreement and Order ("Agreement") is made this 22 day of December, 2008 between the New Hampshire Insurance Department ("Department") and Donald T. Thompson, III ("Respondent").

WHEREAS, the Department issued an Order to Show Cause and Notice of Hearing ("Show Cause Order") dated May 2, 2008 against Respondent; and

WHEREAS, the Respondent disputes that he violated any insurance laws of the State of New Hampshire or that he committed any violations of New Hampshire statutes, rules, regulations or orders of the Commissioner of the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Respondent expressly denies any wrongdoing alleged by the Department relating to the Show Cause Order and further denies any actual or potential violation, fault, wrongdoing or liability in connection with any of the facts or claims that have been or could have been alleged against him by the Department in the Show Cause Order or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to resolve this matter without hearing in order to bring finality to the disputed issues.

NOW THEREFORE, for purposes of settling the above-referenced matter and in lieu of further administrative proceedings the Department and Respondent have reached an agreement as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted, incorporated into and made a part of this Settlement Agreement and Order.
2. With advice of counsel, the Respondent knowingly waives his right to be heard in a hearing in this matter.
3. The Respondent agrees to pay Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to the New Hampshire Insurance Department. This amount shall be payable upon Respondent's execution of this Agreement.
4. This agreement is a compromise of disputed claims. This agreement is not to be construed, considered, or understood by anyone as an admission of liability, wrongdoing, or culpability on the part of the Respondent. The Respondent expressly denies any and

all liability, wrongdoing, and culpability regarding anything alleged, claimed or that could have been alleged or claimed in the Show Cause Order.

5. By entering into this Settlement Agreement And Order, the Department intends to resolve all matters raised in the Show Cause Order, including all of the claims and allegations, and any other claims or allegations made or which could have been made by the Department prior to the effective date of this Settlement Agreement And Order, and the Department will not take any further action with respect to any of the allegations or claims in the Show Cause Order or with respect to any allegations or claims which could have been made by the Department prior to the effective date of this Settlement Agreement And Order. By entering into this Settlement Agreement And Order, the Department and the Respondent intend to resolve all issues relating to the matters raised in the Show Cause Order and any other claim of violation or potential violation made or which could have been made by the Department prior to the effective date of this Settlement Agreement And Order, including any alleged violations of laws, rules, regulations or orders of the Commissioner, and this Settlement Agreement And Order shall be deemed a complete settlement and full and final resolution, and is in lieu of any other action that could have been taken by the Department relating to all matters raised in the Show Cause Order and any other claim of violation or potential violation made, or which could have been made by the Department prior to the effective date of this Settlement Agreement And Order.

6. This Agreement shall be fully enforceable in the State of New Hampshire in any Superior Court convenient to the Department.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


